

Recreational Pay Up

General guidelines for a recreational player to play “up” one age level for ages U8-U11

1} A player may play up one age level if they are grade appropriate for that age group and can show proof of this fact.

2} A player may play up one age level if they are from an outlying area and their only option to play with YYSAs is to play with an older team in their area.

3} The following guidelines will be used if either of these two criteria are not met.

A} A formal written request to play up must be received by the YYSAs office no later than January 15th for the Spring season or July 15th for the Fall season.

B} A \$15 non-refundable fee will apply to all applicants.

C} An evaluation will be performed by a striker level coach at his/her availability.

D} Evaluations will be done on a first come first serve basis, refunds will be given to those who do not get evaluated.

E} If approved to play up, the player will be placed according to YYSAs guidelines.

F} A player may be evaluated only once per seasonal year.

G. If it is the coach of the team's daughter or son, the coach must find a replacement coach. Before he or she request for his player to play up.
