

Yakima Youth Soccer Complex

Our Project:

Yakima Youth Soccer Association, in cooperation with the City of Yakima, is proposing to construct a 34-acre soccer complex on city-owned property east of Interstate 82 and south of State Route 24/Nob Hill Boulevard. In addition to beautifying the highway corridor, this project will be financed with YYSAs funds, private donations, and grants. YYSAs will maintain the complex and will be responsible for all operations as well.

The Yakima Youth Soccer Complex will include the following features:

- Abundant parking
- Connections to the Yakima Greenway
- Maintenance/administration building
- Concessions and restrooms
- Children's play area
- Nature trail & picnic area
